As an active member of the interprofessional teams, the Psychologist is responsible for providing consultation, supervision, testing, assessments and interpretations, interventions and follow-up care, for clients with a wide range of physical and mental health issues. The Psychologist also engages in research, program development and evaluation, and liaising with community agencies.

- Registration or eligibility for registration with the College of Psychologists of Ontario
- Experience in the provision of psychological services, including psychotherapy and behavior management techniques (training and experience in DBT an asset) to individuals with cognitive limitations and responsive behaviours
- Demonstrated skills in assessment, intervention and therapy related to adjustment issues, depression, anxiety and anxiety related disorders
- Skill/experience in the administration and interpretation of psychological tests
- Experience providing supervision to non-registered staff and/or students
- Experience in program evaluation, data collection and analysis
- Must be able to work independently, as well as within an interprofessional team setting
