Two Tenure Track Positions: Clinical Psychology

The Department of Psychology at Memorial University of Newfoundland invites applications for two tenure track positions in Clinical Psychology at the rank of Assistant Professor (VPA-PSYC-2015-001 and VPA-PSYC-2015-002). Although the areas of expertise are open for both positions, we encourage individuals with expertise in child clinical to apply for one of the positions. The successful candidates (1) will have a doctorate from a CPA- or APA-accredited clinical psychology programme, (2) will have completed a CPA- or APA-accredited internship in clinical psychology, (3) will be Registered or eligible for Registration in Newfoundland and Labrador, and (4) will show evidence of an active research program. In addition to teaching undergraduate psychology courses at both upper and lower levels, the successful candidates will also teach core courses in the Psy.D. Programme, and will help supervise and mentor the clinical graduate students.

Applicants should submit (1) a curriculum vitae; (2) a statement of their research interests three selected reprints; (3) a statement of their teaching interests and evidence of effective teaching; and (4) the names, mailing addresses and email addresses of three referees to:
